Pool Rules

The Pickerington Community Pool is a safety conscious aquatic facility. The management will strive at all times to keep it that way. Please direct any complaints and report any incidents immediately to the management.

Guest Policy

- A member may bring a guest for a \$7 admittance charge.
- Each member is personally responsible for their guests and their behavior.

General Pool Rules

- Membership ID cards must be presented by pool patrons each time they enter the pool.
- Children under 12 years old must have a guardian present (at least 13 years old).
- No profanity or obscene behavior will be tolerated.
- The rules and requests made by lifesaving personnel must always be followed.
- No inappropriate PDA is allowed.
- Emergency procedures must be observed. Swimmers must leave the pool area immediately upon the request of the Pool Manager.
- Animals are not allowed in the building or pool area, with the exception of guide dogs.
- The Pool Manager on duty may close the entire pool, or any portions of the pool, for any safety or maintenance reason.
- Acceptable swim attire must be worn. Patrons with religious concerns regarding modesty may wear clean, covering garments that do not interfere with their safety.
- Do not leave wallets, purses, and other valuables unattended anywhere. The City of Pickerington is not responsible for lost or stolen property.

Pool Area Rules

- Walk; don't run in and around the pool facility.
- No pushing, spitting, or throwing water.
- No sitting/hanging on the ropes.
- Diving is permitted only in the diving well.
- No chicken-fighting or horseplay.
- No hanging on the basketball hoop.
- Children under 5 are permitted in the baby pool.

For violation of any rules, the management reserves the right to suspend the violator's membership privileges or revoke the membership without refund for the rest of the season.

Diving Well - Diving is a potentially dangerous activity! Divers must assume all risk of head and bodily injury!

- Divers must pass the swim test, swim strongly across the width of the diving well (12meters), in order to go off the diving boards.
- Only one diver at a time on the boards. Divers must wait for the person ahead of them to reach the pool ladder prior to diving off the board.
- No flotation devices or goggles/eyewear are permitted while using the diving boards.
- Divers must surface in the diving area and exit at the closest ladder.
- No gainers, inward dives, sit bounces, or back dives of any kind are allowed.
- Divers may only make one approach and one bounce per dive.
- Divers may not be helped by someone in the water.
- No swimming is allowed in the diving area.

Slide Rules

- In order to go down the slide swimmers must be able to comfortably swim to the ladder without stopping or assistance.
- Swimmers must wait for the person ahead of them to reach the pool ladder prior to going down the slide.
- Those going down the slide may not be helped/caught by someone in the water.
- Must go down feet first on your bottom.
- No flotation devices are allowed.

Prohibited Items

- Alcohol/Glass containers.
- Flotation devices are not permitted unless they are Coast Guard Approved.
- Hard footballs, baseballs, golf balls, etc., only basketballs and Nerf or swimming balls are allowed.
- Any other item that creates a hazard to patrons or to the operation of the pool.

Breaks

There will be a 15 minute rest periods each hour and all swimmers under 18 must get out of the pool. The exception is children under 3 while accompanied by a parent.

Modifications for Persons With Disabilities

The City of Pickerington will make reasonable modifications to the Pool Rules and Regulations for any person with a qualified disability. Any person requesting modifications to these rules and regulations must identify the qualified individual with a disability to the Pool Manager and request such modification on each visit upon entering the Pickerington Community Pool.

For violation of any rules, the management reserves the right to suspend the violator's membership privileges or revoke the membership without refund for the rest of the season.
